Thanks for purchasing template and for supporting our work. Boxus is our new fancy template. Responsive, clean and professional look with sleek design will satisfy all your needs. All parts are nested in divs which representing each menu item section.

You will need basic HTML, CSS, jQuery skills to edit Boxus HTML. We will try to help you out with this documentation.

HTML Structure

Boxus consist one major HTML file:

- index.html - Big front page

Big front page (Index.html) consist of several sections (Home, Services, Portfolio, About, Blog, Skills, Contact). Each section is separated and start with code like this:

<div id="services" class="section">

<!-- Portfolio -->
<div id="portfolio" class="section">

Portfolio Items

Code for Portfolio item looks like this:

```
<div class="grid-item element-item p_one">
```

    <div class="portfolio-text-wrapper">

```

In first line, important class is “**p_one**” - this mean, the item is only one in row (full width). If you want to have two items in row, you need to use “**p_one_half**” class.

Sliders Configuration

Code for image slider in about page (code for all sliders is similar) is this:

```

<script>
    var aboutImage_speed = "500";
    var aboutImage_auto = "false";
    var aboutImage_hover = "true";
</script>
<div class="image-slider-wrapper relative img aboutImage">
    <a id="aboutImage_next" class="image_slider_next" href="#"></a>
    <div class="caroufredsel_wrapper">
        <ul id="aboutImage" class="image-slider slides">
            <li></li>
            <li></li>
            <li></li>
        </ul>
    </div>
    <div class="clear"></div>
</div>

```

If you need one more slider, duplicate that code and change “**aboutImage**” string on several places with new string, for example “**aboutImage2**”. So you will have “**aboutImage2_speed**”, “**aboutImage2_auto**”, id=“**aboutImage2_next**”, id=“**aboutImage2**”

Use the same logic for any other slider (slider on Service page, Testimonial slider...)

Mail Configuration

Note: Do not remove any quote or double quote signs while doing this.

One notice: this will be functional only on your server, php file can not be executed on your local computer.

Just add your own email address here in your config.php file.
